3. Fire Hazard Controls

4. Fire Detection

- Is there an automatic fire alarm system?
- Does the fire alarm system include automatic detection?
- Are regular false fire alarm activations not experienced?
- Is the fire alarm tested weekly and recorded as such?

5. Fire Extinguishers

- Are hand held fire extinguishers readily accessible and signed?
- Are automatic fire extinguishing systems provided?

- Are appropriate types of hand held fire extinguishers available?
- Are hand held fire extinguishers inspected and maintained?
- Are automatic fire extinguishing systems tested and maintained?

6. Fire Escape

- Is there an emergency evacuation procedure?
- Are arrangements in place to evacuate disabled individuals?
- Is the number, type and travel distance of fire escape routes suitable?
- Can doors on fire escape routes be opened easily?
- Is emergency escape lighting provided as appropriate?
- Are fire drills undertaken periodically (e.g. every 6 months)?

- Does the evacuation procedure include a roll call?
- Are fire action notices displayed throughout the premises?
- Are fire escape routes signed and kept free from obstruction?
- Do doors on fire escape routes open in the direction of travel?
- Are emergency lighting systems tested and maintained?
- Are evacuation times calculated and recorded?
