KEY NETWORK THEMES

Projects that increase our community's access to:

- Food growing skills & opportunities
- Cooking skills & opportunities
- Food sharing e.g. community cafes, food banks and any other way of sharing food







CHALLENGES

Cooking – food education, places to run cooking sessions, knowing what to do with ingredients, budgeting

Food – storage, waste & collection

Funding - duplication of services/groups bidding against each other for same funding

Information – wrap around support e.g. benefits, signposting

Time & money - volunteers becoming members of service, working & running projects

Rural areas - transport, statistics don't help us to get funding

Connecting people - with services, those who want to volunteer or set up own project?
