CHALLENGES

Cooking – food education, places to run cooking sessions, knowing what to do with ingredients, budgeting

Food – storage, waste & collection

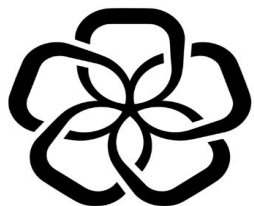
Funding - duplication of services/groups bidding against each other for same funding

Information – wrap around support e.g. benefits, signposting

Time & money - volunteers becoming members of service, working & running projects

Rural areas – transport, statistics don't help us to get funding

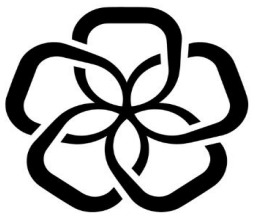
